Helping Our Children Reach Their Full Potential

- In 2014, your gifts supported over 2,000 children and families to receive services from The Children's Center, which provides parents of special needs and/or typically developing children with numerous health, therapy, education and child development programs in a single location.

Specifically, you helped provide:

- 401 visits to Respite Care (Parents Night Out) which targets special need children and their siblings.
- 364 visits to the new mom support group MAK (Moms and Kidz Support Group).
- 310 children with early care and education services.
- Physical, occupational and speech therapy services to nearly 250 children.
- 13 scholarships for children to attend Parrish Early Care and Education.



Growing Our Community

- For over 20 years, you have invested in the future by awarding medical scholarships to residents in North Brevard County who are pursuing careers that one day will provide healing care to our community. During the 2014-2015 school year, you helped award \$17,500 in scholarships to 21 high school and college students.
- Thanks to you, Nicole Jordan was the Karla Foster, RN, Memorial Scholarship recipient of \$3,000. The scholarship was established by Doug Foster in loving memory of his wife, Karla, who was a nurse at Parrish Medical Center for more than 22 years.
- JPMF is dedicated to supporting and enhancing healthcare outreach, patient care, rehabilitation, and wellness services that contribute to a better quality of life for citizens in North Brevard. The community grants committee provided 11 nonprofits with grants totaling over \$40,000.

Providing Health and Wellness Services For Our Community

- Thanks to your support of the annual benefit gala and Parrish Medical Center's employee giving program, the Women's Center North Guild now has a permanent home in North Brevard to provide programs and services for domestic violence victims.
 - Due to the opening of the new Titusville location, there was a 26% increase in clients served with a total of 762 served in 2014.
- You helped 110 uninsured patients received free mammogram screenings and over 52 breast cancer patients receive vital services and education.
- The Cancer Care Boutique served 78 patients which were either uninsured or underinsured.
- Through the Insulin Voucher program, your gift provided 25 patients with a 30-day supply of life saving medication.

- The Carey Guest House, which provides lodging for visitors with a hospitalized loved one, had 84 visitors stay a total of 313 days in 2014.
